Re: Support for SB 1574

Dear Senator Uresti:

On behalf of the Texas EMS Alliance (TEMSA), I am writing to offer our strong support for SB 1574. TEMSA was founded in 2013 by a diverse alliance of Texas EMS providers to provide a public policy voice that will enhance the future of EMS in Texas. Today, TEMSA represents over 50 entities that provide EMS services, including city-operated EMS, non-profit entities that provide EMS services to cities and regions, and ambulance companies that provide outsourced EMS services to underserved communities.

SB 1574 would provide critical support to Texas EMS providers and fire personnel (both paid and volunteer). It would allow emergency response employees to receive the same information that peace officers are entitled to when they come in contact with bodily fluids during the course or scope of their employment.

Today, law enforcement have access to mandatory and court ordered testing of arrested individuals if the officers were exposed to the suspect's bodily fluids. EMS providers and fire personnel do not have these same protections when exposed to an individual's bodily fluids.

SB 1574 would require each organization to have an infection control officer who can work with hospital and public health personnel to deliver test results and treatment plans to exposed EMS providers and their physicians in a timely manner. Today, without SB 1574, the individual's bodily fluids are tested and then sent to the local health department, whose officials are then expected to track down the exposed EMS provider and report the results to them. Unfortunately, this creates a significant delay for the EMS provider, who may need immediate medical attention.

Again, thank you for introducing this important piece of legislation. We look forward to working with lawmakers to ensure that SB 1574 is signed into law.
